I TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING (TCM)

The first Team Captains' Meeting (TCM) for Ski and Snowboard Cross will be held on 18 January at the Welli Hilli Park Ski Resort. The meeting will take place in the Grand Ballroom I (2nd floor) of the Main Building. The complete TCM will be published as an appendix after the Detailed Competition Activity Schedule is completed.

SPORT INFORMATION DESK (SID)

The Sport Information Desk (SID) will be operated at the competition venue and the Youth Olympic Village Gangneung. At the Youth Olympic Village Gangneung (YVG),

At the Ski and Snowboard Cross competition venue, the SID will be located in the Race Office, in the Grand Ballroom I (2nd floor) of the Main Building at the Welli Hilli Park Ski Resort. The SID Crews will provide general sport information for the Freestyle Skiing and Snowboard Cross and assist with basic requirements and inquiries.

COMPETITION FORMAT

During Gangwon 2024, there will be six (6) events in Ski and Snowboard Cross. All these competitions will take place at the Welli Hilli Park Ski Resort. The competition formats are the following.

SKI/SNOWBOARD CROSS W/M

- Ski and Snowboard Cross events are tournaments in which groups of competitors compete against each other on a specifically prepared cross course that includes various types of turns, jumps, waves and other freestyle terrain features, advancing through the pre-heat, group heats, semifinals, and finals.
- Ranking at the end of a heat is determined by the order of crossing the finish line.
- · Qualification consists of three or four competitors in a pool; each competitor in the same pool competes against all others in a round robin scheme. The top four competitors from each pool advance to the next round.
- Starting from group heats, ranking at the end of a heat is determined by the order of crossing the finish line.

MIXED TEAM SKI/SNOWBOARD CROSS

- Each team has two members: the male athlete will start first, followed by the female athlete.
- Each team member will make one run, following each other as a relay.

· Before the start of wave 1 (men's run), all start doors open simultaneously. Once the teammate cross the finish line and the results of wave 1 are confirmed, the starting gate will automatically open for the wave 2 (women's run) with the time delay registered by the result of the first team competitors. A maximum penalty time difference may occur.

RULES

TIE BREAK RULES

• If it is not possible to determine the ranking of the second team-competitors for two or more teams or individuals (tie), the team or the athlete with the better FID seed ranks will win the tie breaker.

PENALTIES / DISQUALIFICATION RULES

- Penalties/disqualifications may be imposed by the Jury against a competitor in the following circumstances:
 - Ranking of Competitors that did not start (DNS)
 - Ranking of Competitors that did not finish (DNF)
 - Ranking of Competitors that are sanctioned for an in race interference (WRG, RAL, DSQ)
 - Disqualifies for unsportsmanlike behavior (DQB)
- A competitor or team that is disqualified for unsportsmanlike behavior (DQB) or for a Red Card (DSQ) sanction will not be ranked in any phase and will be listed separately.

PROTESTS / APPEALS

- Protests must be submitted in writing in one of the official FIS languages.
- A protest is considered if it is submitted to the jury members no later than 15 minutes after the end of the competition and is accompanied by a deposit of CHF 100 or equivalent.
- At the group heat rounds a protest has to be admitted before the next heat begins.
- Jury decisions regarding in race interference cannot be protested or cannot be appealed.
- The competition jury will handle protests in accordance with FIS rules and regulations.

The Welli Hilli Park Ski Resort is located in Hoengseong and was opened in December 1995. It hosted the 2009 Snowboard World Championships.

SPORT EQUIPMENT STORAGE

In the Competition Venue (Welli Hilli Park Ski Resort) for Ski and Snowboard Cross, there will be wax cabins assigned to each NOC where athletes can store their equipment.

IATHLETES' LOUNGE

The Athletes' Lounge will open daily according to the official training and competition schedules. All competitors can use the lounge for two hours before and one hour after both the official training and the competition. The detailed operation schedule will be re-announced once confirmed.

The following services will be available:

· Chairs, tables, Olympic sponsored soft drinks, bottled water, hot soup, fruits, cookies, and energy bars

SECURITY

SECURITY MANAGEMENT AT COMPETITION VENUES

Certain part of some competition venues will be designated as restricted areas. Such restricted areas as well as their surrounding areas will be patrolled by security staff or relevant organizations. To enter the venue, visitors are requested to present their YOAC or valid admission tickets.

- Safety of the surrounding areas of the venues
 - Police mobile unit will be dispatched to patrol on regular basis and maintain the order.
 - Police stations and fire stations in the region will be ready for emergency dispatches at all times.

- Restricted and prohibited items
 - Please refer to the list of prohibited and restricted items in in the SEC chapter of the SEC chapter of the CdM Guide (Annex 1).

SECURITY AT OTHER EVENTS AND VENUES

The security will be provided for all events and venues of Gangwon 2024.

- The maintenance of public, both inside and outside of the venue, will be monitored to ensure the safety of spectators during the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
- Relevant organizations, such as the police and fire brigade will conduct regular patrols at the NOC Hotels. A direct communication channel will be established between the NOC Hotels and the Gangwon 2024 SEC Team.
- Fire facilities will be inspected in advance, and fire truck and ambulances will be stationed in the nearest possible location to promptly respond to any emergencies.
