

# ISU — SKATING

All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the “Identifications on NOC Team Apparel Practical Guidelines”, and General Guidelines (released Summer 2023) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

## SUBMISSION PROCESS

Markings on the clothes may be measured by the Officials onsite for compliance while being worn. In addition, Athletes have to present their sport equipment and accessories to be checked upon request by IF Officials.

## 01 SPEED SKATING FRONT

### Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Clothing

- Competition clothing | Warm-up suits (incl. one-piece body suit)**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* [ ■ ] per clothing item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>. One identification of the manufacturer will be permitted on Zippers and Buttons and should appear in the same colour as the concerned item (i.e. tone on tone), as long as such identifications are deemed not conspicuous by the IOC.
- One-piece bodysuit**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.
- Neck Guard**  
 The *Identification of the Manufacturer* on neck guards will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>. If the neck guard is part of the competition suit, no *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on the collar or neck.
- Collar and roll necks**  
 If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no identification of the manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Gloves**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 8cm<sup>2</sup> per gloves, to a total maximum size of 16cm<sup>2</sup> for a pair of gloves. Gloves must be of white colour.
- Headgear**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per Item, with a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup> or two Identifications of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm<sup>2</sup> each and placed above each ear.

- Eyewear**  
 May carry the Manufacturer Identification as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

#### Sports Equipment

- Helmets**  
 Two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* will be permitted on the helmet (max 20cm<sup>2</sup> per identification), to a total maximum size of 40cm<sup>2</sup>. The helmet may include the Skater's own name and/or national country flag, as well as individual decorations according to ISU rules. Front part of the helmet (max 40cm<sup>2</sup>) is reserved for the Winter Youth Olympic Games Logo. Side parts are reserved for numbers.

#### Accessories

- Bag**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Tights | Overshoes | Ankle protectors**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Towels**  
 No *Identification of the Manufacturer* or 3rd Party identifications may appear on towels.

#### Skates/Footwear

- Skates (incl. boots, blades, blade guards and blade connections)**  
 The identification of the Manufacturer shall reflect standard commercial practices for each piece of equipment, 1 manufacturer identification with a maximum of 20cm<sup>2</sup> on each boot, 1 manufacturer identification with a maximum of 20cm<sup>2</sup> on each blade guard and 1 manufacturer identification of max 6cm<sup>2</sup> on each connecting construction. On each blade the manufacturer identification shall not exceed 20cm<sup>2</sup> as follows: one (1) manufacturer identification of maximum 20cm<sup>2</sup> or a combination of one (1) manufacturer identification of maximum 10cm<sup>2</sup> and one (1) product technology identification of maximum 10cm<sup>2</sup>. Instead of the Manufacturer Identification the Skater's own name may be engraved on pieces of equipment, with the same size restrictions as for trademarks.

#### Product Technology Identification

#### Clothing

- Competition clothing | Warm-up suits (incl. one-piece body suit)**  
 One additional *Product Technology Identification* [ ● ] will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup>.

#### One-piece bodysuit

One *Product Technology Identification* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

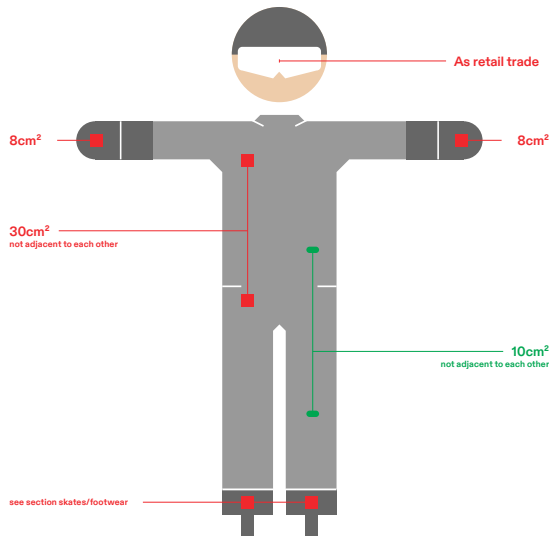

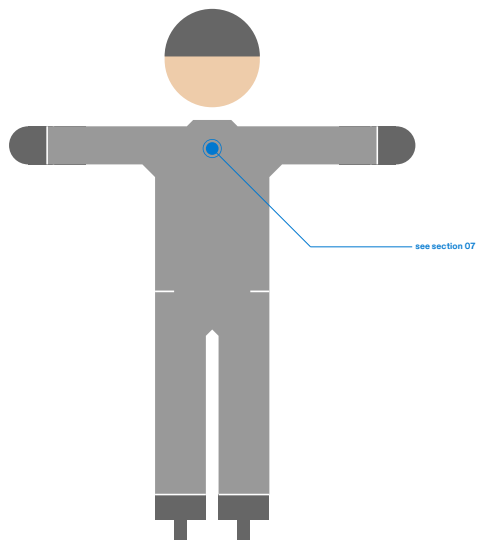
#### NOC Emblem and National Identity

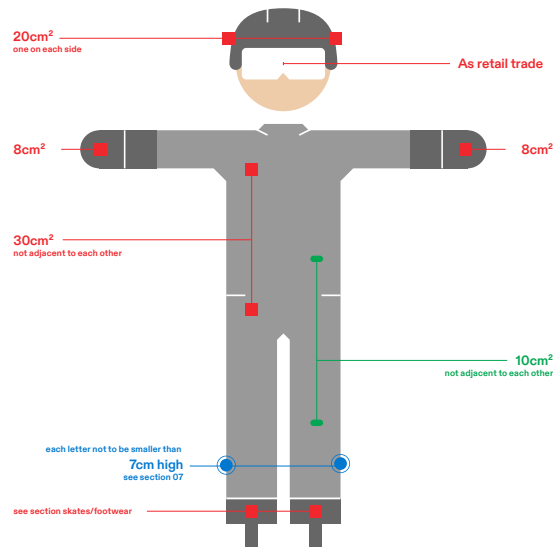

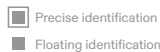

## 03 SHORT TRACK SPEED SKATING

### Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Clothing

- Neck Guard**  
 The *Identification of the Manufacturer* on neck guards will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>. If the neck guard is part of the competition suit, no *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on the collar or neck.
- Collar and roll necks**  
 If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no identification of the manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Gloves**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 8cm<sup>2</sup> per gloves, to a total maximum size of 16cm<sup>2</sup> for a pair of gloves. Gloves must be of white colour.
- Headgear**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per item, with a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup> or two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm<sup>2</sup> each and placed above each ear.
- Eyewear**  
 May carry the *Manufacturer Identification* as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

#### Sports Equipment

- Helmets**  
 Two *Identifications of the Manufacturer* will be permitted on the helmet (max 20cm<sup>2</sup> per identification), to a total maximum size of 40cm<sup>2</sup>. The helmet may include the Skater's own name and/or national country flag, as well as individual decorations according to ISU rules. Front part of the helmet (max 40cm<sup>2</sup>) is reserved for the Winter Youth Olympic Games Logo. Side parts are reserved for numbers.

#### Accessories

- Bag**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.

- Tights | Overshoes | Ankle protectors**  
 One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per accessory item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Towels**  
 No *Identification of the Manufacturer* or 3rd Party identifications may appear on towels.

#### Skates/Footwear

- Skates (incl. boots, blades, blade guards and blade connections)**  
 The *Identification of the Manufacturer* shall reflect standard commercial practices for each piece of equipment, 1 manufacturer identification with a maximum of 20cm<sup>2</sup> on each boot, 1 manufacturer identification with a maximum of 20cm<sup>2</sup> on each blade guard and 1 manufacturer identification of max 6cm<sup>2</sup> on each connecting construction. On each blade the manufacturer identification shall not exceed 20cm<sup>2</sup> as follows: one (1) manufacturer identification of maximum 20cm<sup>2</sup> or a combination of one (1) manufacturer identification of maximum 10cm<sup>2</sup> and one (1) product technology identification of maximum 10cm<sup>2</sup>. Instead of the *Manufacturer Identification* the Skater's own name may be engraved on pieces of equipment, with the same size restrictions as for trademarks.

### Product Technology Identification

#### Clothing

- Competition clothing | Warm-up suits (incl. one-piece body suit)**  
 One additional *Product Technology Identification* [ ■ ] will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup>.  
**One-piece bodysuit**  
 One *Product Technology Identification* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

In Short Track Speed Skating the official NOC abbreviation shall be placed on the external part of both lower legs, the size of the characters not to be smaller than 7cm high and the letters shall be placed vertically from knee to ankle. The country name, abbreviation or team identity may also be placed on the back of the upper body (letters of minimum 5cm and maximum 15cm high).

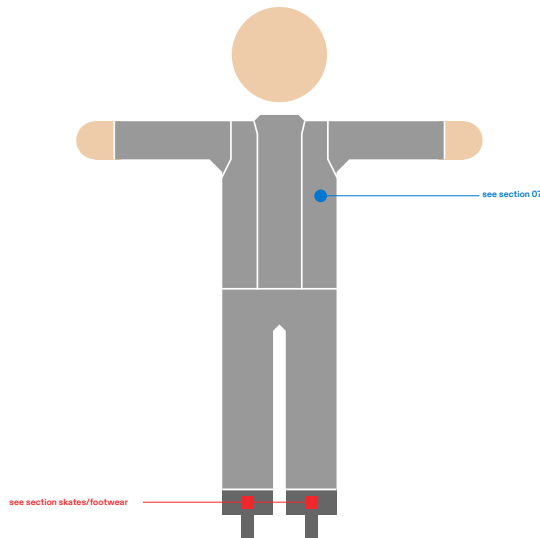

## 03 FIGURE SKATING

### Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Clothing

- **Competition clothing (costumes) (Incl. Figure Skating exhibition)**  
No Identification of the Manufacturer will be permitted on the Competition Clothing (costumes), including gloves.
- **Neck Guard**  
The *Identification of the Manufacturer* on neck guards will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>.  
If the neck guard is part of the competition suit, no *Identification of the Manufacturer* may appear on the collar or neck.
- **Warm-up suit and “Kiss & Cry area” clothing**  
During the official Warm-Up phase before the competition performance, during practice sessions and other off-ice activities in the “Kiss-and-Cry area”, TV interviews and the off-ice victory ceremonies, the following Identifications will be permitted: One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per clothing item, to a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.
- **Collar and roll necks**  
If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no identification of the manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one *Identification of the Manufacturer* will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.
- **Socks | Gloves**  
Please refer to general principles.
- **Headgear**  
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per Item, with a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup> or two Identifications of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm<sup>2</sup> each and placed above each ear.
- **Eyewear**  
May carry the Manufacturer Identification as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Winter Youth Olympic Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

#### Accessories

- **Bag**  
One *Identification of the Manufacturer* per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.
- **Tights | Overshoes | Ankle protectors**  
One Identification of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 20cm<sup>2</sup>.
- **Towels**  
No Identification of the Manufacturer or 3rd Party identifications may appear on towels.

#### Skates/Footwear

- **Skates**  
No markings are permitted on boots or blades, except for the boot manufacturer’s name on the boot heel not larger than 10cm<sup>2</sup> and 1 engraved identification of the manufacturer not larger than 20cm<sup>2</sup> on each blade and each blade guard..

#### Clothing

- **Competition clothing | Warm-up suits (incl. one-piece body suit)**  
One additional *Product Technology Identification* [ ■ ] will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup>.  
**One-piece bodysuit**  
One *Product Technology Identification* shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum size noted above; however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.
