

4.1. SPORT EQUIPMENT

NOCs are required to bring their own sport equipment in order to compete in the respective discipline, with two exceptions:

- Bobsleigh: the monobobs will be provided by the IBSF as per distribution regulation set by IBSF
- Curling: the stones will be provided by Gangwon 2024

Storage of Personal Sport Equipment

As a general principle, sport equipment is not allowed in the Youth Olympic Villages (YVG/YVH).

5.1. SPORT INFORMATION DESK (SID)

The Sport Information Desk (SID) will be operated at each competition venue.

- The following sport/discipline-related information will be provided at the SID:
- General sport information for respective sport/discipline
- Competition and training schedule (including schedule updates)
- Start lists, draws and results
- Ad-hoc/urgent communication from respective IF and competition management
- Weather updates (twice a day: early morning and late afternoon)
- Weather notice including weather information, hazardous weather information and unusual weather is provided via website (www.gw2024.org)
- Daily / hourly forecast, short-term forecast (3-4days) and mid-term forecast (7-10 days)

5.1.2. WEATHER AND CLIMATE INFORMATION

- Provides point forecast for each venue (Gangneung, Pyeongchang, Jeongseon, Hoengseong venue)
- Two weather forecasters each deployed to Pyeongchang, Jeongseon, and Hoengseong venues
- Weather observation equipment is installed at 1 ice venue and 8 snow venues to provide temperature, wind direction, and wind spee d on a per-minute basis.
- All data is provided in real time through the weather information web.
- Operate weather observation vehicles in preparation for dangerous weather.

5.1.2. WEATHER AND CLIMATE INFORMATION

General Weather and Climate Information

- The average temperature in January in Gangneung, where the ice games are held, is about 2 degrees, the average maximum temperature is 7 d egrees, the average minimum temperature is -2 degrees, and the average wind speed is about 2.6 m/s.
- In Snow sports area, where the snow games are held, the average temperature in January is about -6 degrees, the average maximum temperat ure is -1 degree, the average minimum temperature is -12 degrees, and the average wind speed is about 3.5 m/s.
- Since the weather in Snow sports area is cold, it is recommended to bring gloves and warm clothes.
- The Gangneung area has an altitude of about 20 to 50 meters above sea level, but in the Snow sports area, there are many areas with an altitude e of about 500 to 800 meters.
- As for the weather, there are relatively more cloudy days in the Snow sports area, which is at a higher altitude, than in the Gangneung area.
- Weather information can be found on website (www.gw2024.org).
- The Gangwon 2024 Olympic Organizing Committee plans to produce point forecasts for the venues during the Games and provide the weather through a specially built website.

5.3. ATHLETES' LOUNGE

All competing athletes will have access to an indoor heated Athletes' Lounge at their respective Competition Venue, where they can relax before, between or after their competitions.

- The food and beverage services (snacks and refreshment etc.) will be provided at athletes' lounge.
- The Athletes' Lounges will be:
- equipped with chairs and tables
- open each day in coordination with the competition and training schedule
- In principle, the lounges will open two hours before and close one hour after the last competition ends for the sport(s) involved. Where needed and based on transport arrival times, the lounge will be open earlier and closer later.

5.4. ACCESS TO SKI LIFTS FOR JHO AND WHP

All competing athletes, team officials and other workforces needing access to the ski lifts, will be equipped with Youth Olympic Accreditation Card (YOAC) giving them free access to the ski resort during their period of stay. Non-accredited clients will be ineligible for free access to ski lifts.

For the Athletes' Families and Friends (AFFs), the Athletes' Family and Friend Lift Pass(AFF Lift Pass) will allow them to have free access to ski lifts/gondolas without wearing skis and spectator areas. Please refer to CdM Guide - TKT Chapter. The pass issuance process is as follows:

- (1) CdM or Proxy Holder apply for the AFF Lift Pass at the NOC Service Centre(One day before use)
- (2) Gangwon 2024 Accreditation Team receives the list(Name of Athletes & AFFs) and confirms the application
- (3) AFFs pick up the AFF Lift Pass at the Accreditation Centre located at the venue
- (4) AFFs return the AFF Lift Pass to the Accreditation Centre after the usage (on the same day)

6.5. FLUOR BAN IMPLEMENTATION - FIS DISCIPLINES

FIS has confirmed the ban of using fluorine waxes and that random testing will be carried. This is in line with their announcement of the full implementation of the fluor wax ban at the start of the 2023/24 winter season.

Please refer to the FIS fluor ban implementation documents on the FIS Website and the Gangwon 2024 extranet for more information on procedures and consequences per discipline. The implementation of these rules will apply to all FIS disciplines with the exception of Ski Jumping (and the Ski Jumping part of Nordic Combined). Please also note that the number of tests and venues will remain confidential by FIS.

6.6. FLUOR BAN IMPLEMENTATION - BIATHLON

According to the common waxing protocol for IBU Events (see "attached"), only fluorine-free wax is allowed, and the prohibited wax includes any kind of products containing fluorocarbons, and the competitions will be operated accordingly.
